

Black Oak Bingo

1. Pass out the bingo cards and piles of "chips"
2. Ask students to look carefully at the cards and to describe the cards. Make sure that they are orientated to the bingo card columns (Adaptations, Habitat, Kind, Interrelationships, Appearance)
3. Tell students that when you call off an animal they may place a chip on one square that applies. (Alternatively, you could play black out version where students mark all squares that apply) Students call out bingo for five in a row.
4. Draw an animal card or call out any animal you choose

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
