DRESS CODE

Foothill Horizons Summer Camp is about Friendship, Imagination, Fun and Independence. Everyone grade 3 and older should feel safe and comfortable at all times. The following dress code has been developed to ensure that no one will feel offended or uncomfortable. If campers choose to dress inappropriately, campers will be asked to change and provided with alternate clothing as needed.

Clothing should be appropriate for young children, cover private areas and underwear. Swimsuits must be modestly cut.

The following will not be allowed for Staff, Junior Counselors, Counselors in Training and Campers:

- No clothing references to profanity, tobacco, alcohol, drugs, sex, or gangs.
- No exposure of breasts, buttocks, midriff, or genitalia
- No transparent clothing exposing underwear or genitalia.
- No string bikinis, thongs or crochet, transparent swimsuits
